By registering for the event, the participant acknowledges having read and accepted these Terms in full.

### 3. Registration Process

- ☐ Registration is open exclusively to delegates invited or approved by the organizer.

  - ☐ All information provided must be accurate and complete.
  - ☐ Registration will be considered valid only upon confirmation by the organizer and, upon receipt of payment.

### 4. Participation Fees & Payment

- ☐ Applicable registration fees are:

  - International Business Delegate:
    - Package 5 days 1600.00 € Excl. VAT
    - Package 3 days (Sunday, Monday and Tuesday) 1100.00 € Excl. VAT
    - Package 3 days (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday) 1100.00 € Excl. VAT
    - Gala Dinner only 200.00 € Excl. VAT

## 5. Cancellation & Refund Policy

- ☐ Cancellation by the participant must be submitted in writing to the organizer.
  - ☐ Cancellations received **before 1 October 2025** will be refunded **50%** of the participation fee.
  - ☐ **No refunds** will be issued for cancellations received **after 1 October 2025**.
  - ☐ Delegates may transfer their registration to another colleague by notifying the organizer before 20 October 2025.

## 6. Event Modification or Cancellation

The organizer reserves the right to:

- ☐ Modify the content, schedule, venues, or speakers of the event.
- ☐ Cancel the event in case of force majeure or other unforeseen circumstances (e.g. natural disaster, pandemic, political unrest).

In case of cancellation, registration fees will be refunded, excluding any costs incurred by participants (travel, accommodation, etc.).

## 8. Code of Conduct

## 9. Personal Data Protection (GDPR)

The organizer, the **Bordeaux Gironde Chamber of Commerce and Industry**, processes participants' personal data in compliance with the **General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR)**.

### Purposes of processing:

Personal data collected during registration for the "Genesis" Conference will be used for the following purposes:

- ☐ Administrative management of registrations and event logistics;
- ☐ Creation of networking opportunities (delegate list, B2B platform, networking sessions);
- ☐ Distribution of communications related to the event (practical information, reminders, reports, thanks messages, etc.).

### Legal basis:

The processing is based on:

- ☐ The performance of a contract (registration and participation in the event),
- ☐ The consent of participants for the publication of their profile on networking tools or event media,
- ☐ The organizer's legitimate interest in ensuring the smooth delivery of the event and in promoting its initiatives.

### Retention period:

Data is kept for the duration of the preparation and delivery of the event and subsequently for a maximum of 3 years for follow-up and evaluation purposes, unless a deletion request is made beforehand.

### Access to data:

The data is processed exclusively by the organizer and its technical service providers located within the European Union, acting as processors. No data is transferred outside the EU without appropriate safeguards.

**Data subjects' rights:**

In compliance with articles 15-22 of GDPR, participants have the following rights:

- ☐ Right of access to their data,
- ☐ Right of rectification in case of inaccuracies,
- ☐ Right to erasure ("right to be forgotten") under certain conditions,
- ☐ Right to restrict processing,
- ☐ Right to data portability,
- ☐ Right to object, particularly when processing is based on a legitimate interest.

Photos and video recordings may be made during the event for documentation, institutional communication, and promotion, including on the organizer's digital and printed media.

By participating in the event, participants acknowledge that their image may appear in such materials, **unless they submit a written objection to the organizer before 25 October 2025**. Participants may also exercise their **right to object at any time** to the publication of images that allow them to be identified, in conformity with **article 21 of GDPR**.
