



COSM'INNOV instructions for preparation of abstract

Abstract title in Bold Letters, Arial 16pt, centered

A 350 (maximum) word abstract should be provided in English. The abstract should include the new discoveries, results and conclusions which are presented in the paper.

1: Abstract must be on A4 size paper (21.0 x 29.7cm) with top/bottom margins of 2.5 cm and left/right margins of 2.0 cm. It cannot be longer than the one-page space that has been allotted.

2: Your abstract will be submitted and reviewed anonymously to the Scientific Committee's reviewers. Therefore, your abstract should not contain any affiliation, mention of your organization's name, or any commercial product/name that could identify you.

3: The main text must be in Arial 11pt and in single spacing. Indent and fully justify each new paragraph.

4: Formulae, equations and figures should be an integral part of the abstract, with captions in Arial 11pt, and not submitted separately.

5: A short list of references can be added in Arial 11pt.

6: Please delete the red characters in this template before submission.

7: For submission, please convert your abstract from a Word file to an Adobe Acrobat PDF while embedding all the fonts used in it (including those in figures, tables, and pictures) to avoid garbled printout. Please select "High Quality" when you create the PDF file.

8: The title should be a short informative title that contains the major key words. The title should not contain abbreviations.

9: The following structure of the abstract must be observed:

OBJECTIVE: State in a few sentences the purpose and the main objective of the research presented.

MATERIALS & METHODS: Describe in two or three sentences the methods and techniques used in the research. Interventionary studies involving animals are not permitted, and any work involving animal testing will be rejected from presentation at the congress

RESULTS: Relate the main observations of the experiments, selecting pertinent data and discussion points in a few concise sentences.

CONCLUSION: State in one or two sentences the new knowledge and/or understanding resulting from the work

Keywords : Up to six keywords or phrases should be submitted in English for indexing purposes.

The online submission system will open in September 2025. The submission due date is January 9th, 2026 for Oral Communications and **March 13th, 2026 for Posters communications.** One paper submission is acceptable per registration. Each presenting author is requested to register and pay before the congress, by March 31st, 2026, for inclusion of his/her presentation into the COSM'INNOV programme.
